

The recently renovated pool at the Complexe Sportif Claude Robillard was built for and hosted the Water Polo at the 1976 Summer Olympic Games in Montreal. The pool is the home of CAMO Water Polo Club.

The complex is easily reachable by public transport. The 146 East bus leaves from the Crémazie metro station every 30 minutes and stops right in front of the facility. The Crémazie metro station is also 10 minutes from the pool on foot.






Weather

Technical Rules

AQUA rules will be applied with certain restrictions due to technological limitations and age category changes. A 10 goal differential will result in running time. If the differential should close to less than 10 goals, regular time will be implemented again.

Round robin games can end in tie, playoff games will go directly to shoot out

Formal protests must be submitted to the Head referee



Technical Rules

Roster Limits & Substitution

15 players per roster. Teams are not required to have a second goaltender. Any goaltender is required to wear a red cap with the number 1, 13, 14, or 15. Any athlete on a team's signed game roster can be cap switched into a goalie cap (1, 13, 14, 15) during the game in case of injury, as the referee or delegate allows, and otherwise only at halftime. However, regular goaltender substitutions may only be between goaltenders wearing red caps.

**Players and coaches are welcome to play/coach in multiple age categories however in the event of a scheduling conflict, teams must ensure that they have enough players/coaches on each team to participate in both games. **





Requirements for International Clubs

- **Certificate of insurance from the club's national federation naming Water Polo Canada as additional insured**
- **Letter of good standing from the foreign federation listing all participants**
- **Proof of travel medical insurance**
- **Roster with photos for all players and coaches**
